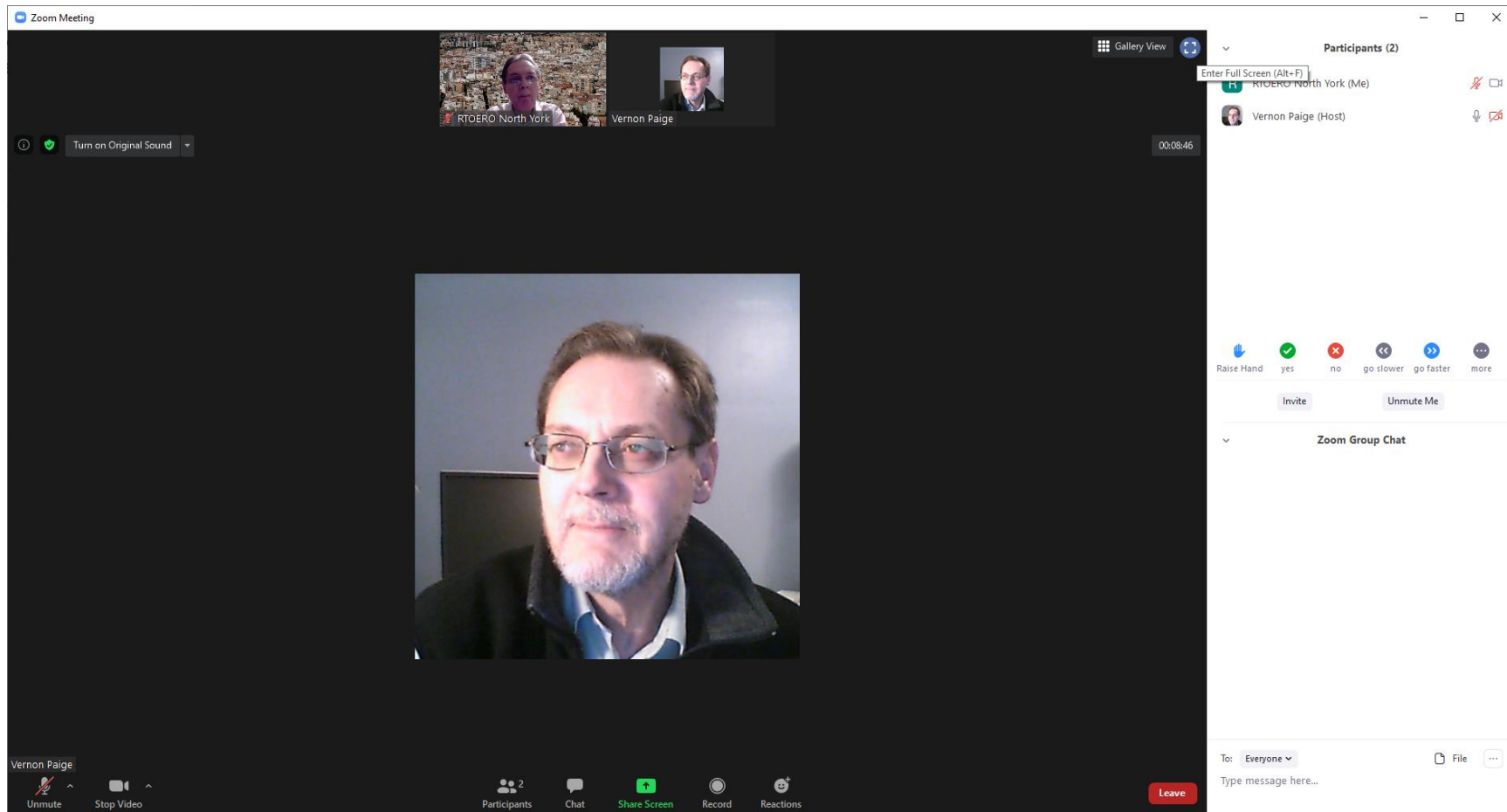


Controls sometimes disappear.

Move your mouse cursor near the edges of the screen (or tap that area on a tablet), try the bottom first.

This is the “Gallery View” showing up to 49 participants, with the current speaker identified by a yellow frame.



This is the “Speaker View”.

Note the little triangle or “up-arrow” beside the “Start/Stop Video” control.

This opens a short menu with 3 items, one of them lets you “Choose a Virtual Background”.

Use a picture on your computer or download a small collection from Zoom.

This does not always work well. It requires a good (fairly fast) Internet connection and a computer with “fairly good video specifications”.

“Video Settings” opens another menu, with more advanced options.

The Virtual Background and other advanced settings can also be accessed in Zoom when you are not in a meeting.
